





GROCERY KITS FOR TRIBAL COMMUNITYTHANKS TO STEP UP CHARITABLE FOUNDATION & WISHING WELL



The COVID crisis and the lock down that followed is now in the unlock phase. However the number of cases has been increasing in Ahmednagar district. This has resulting in creating of new containment zones, and implementation of curfew in hot spots,

Ahmednagar district has tribal community spread in Ahmednagar tehsil, especially in Shrigonda tehsil. Presently we work with 750 tribal community families in the district. Phasepardhi and dombari are the tribes which are mainly found in these areas. With no jobs for daily wage workers, street acrobatic performances stopped and lockdown, these communities were left with no alternatives to feed their families placing them in a dangerous situation. We have continued to provide groceries to this community. The grocery kits cost Rs 1000/per kit for a family of 5.

The tribals were provided survival kits containing- wheat, rice, pulses, lentils, gram flour, cooking oil, salt and spices, soap, toothpaste, sanitizer, peanuts, sugar and tea powder, semolina, beaten rice etc....
